WE'RE ALL IN THIS TOGETHER:

Sunday 11th September is Education Sunday, which "gives us the opportunity to give thanks to God for all who teach and all who study, for all who continually have to find the right words and deliver them with enthusiasm and graciousness... we pray that God will fortify those working to make our schools places of learning and sanctuary – not just teachers and leaders but all the support staff whose tireless work sometimes goes unnoticed. We pray for all our primary and secondary pupils – particularly school leavers who have had such a difficult journey in recent times – not to mention students in higher education and vocational training." (Catholic Bishops Conference of England and Wales). With our educational establishments going back for the new year, let us pray and remember all who are involved.

RESOURCES:

Know your numbers week - Measure, Modify, Manage. This refers to measuring your blood pressure to see if it is under control, modifying your lifestyle if necessary and managing your blood pressure and health to prevent serious illness. The aim of the campaign, supported annually by Cheshire West and Chester Council and Brio Leisure, is to reach those who have high blood pressure and do not know it. People can then access the treatment and support they need to bring it under control. Free blood pressure checks are offered by GPs, pharmacies, some workplaces, some gyms and health clubs and as part of an NHS Health Check or Well Man Clinic. So, know your numbers.

CCS IN ST THERESA'S CAR PARK:

CCS are using the far end of St Theresa's car park as a base for a few months while works to some of Sanctuary's houses are carried out.
