## RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS - A FIRST SCRUTINY

**Anil, Lindsay and John** of our parish took part in the Rite of Election celebrated by Bishop Mark at Shrewsbury Cathedral on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> February. The Bishop declared catechumen **Anil** now

to be a member of the Elect, to be initiated into the sacred mysteries at the Easter Vigil. As part of **Anil's** continuing preparation for entering fully into the Church through the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist, during the 11 am Mass this Sunday Fr William will conduct the First of three Scrutinies with him. These are rites of self-searching and repentance, with a spiritual purpose, performed in these final weeks of preparation.

At the Rite of Election **Lindsay and John**, who are already baptised, were encouraged by Bishop Mark to join in the Lenten spirit of repentance, to hear the Lord's call to conversion and be faithful to their baptismal covenant. At the Easter Vigil, **Anil, Lindsay and John** together will receive the sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist and thereby enter fully into the life of the Church. Please keep them in your prayers.
