WE'RE ALL IN THIS TOGETHER Scientist estimate there are now 170 trillion pieces of plastic floating in the world's oceans. For everyone on earth now, that means about 22,000 pieces of plastic per person! And this figure is growing. We can all do our bit to help: by not using plastic where other materials can be used, by reusing plastics if we can, by recycling those that we can't use or by upcycle them. Did you know that large supermarkets now collect many types of plastic bags, such as those used for salads, apples, and some veg? The bags usually say on them, "Recyclable with bags at large supermarkets". See what you can do to reduce your plastic use, every bit will help. Check out Tear Fund Rubbish Campaign Petition, which seeks to ensure Government negotiations on the Plastics treaty help solve the issues of plastic and plastic waste.
