WE'RE ALL IN THIS TOGETHER:

The World Day of the Poor will be celebrated by the Catholic Church on Sunday 19 November with the theme of "Do not turn your face away from anyone who is poor" (Tobit 4:7). The Pope's message is one that "We are living in times that are not particularly sensitive to the needs of the poor. The pressure to adopt an affluent lifestyle increases, while the voices of those dwelling in poverty tend to go unheard. The poor are persons; they have faces, stories, hearts and souls. They are our brothers and sisters, with good points and bad, like all of us, and it is important to enter into a personal relation with each of them. The Book of Tobit teaches us to be realistic and practical in whatever we do with and for the poor." He ends by saying that "In this house of ours, which is the world, everyone has a right to experience the light of charity; no one must be deprived of that light."
