We're all in this together: So what storm name will it be next, and what weather will be thrown at us. We seem to have had it all over the last few weeks. It reflects life, storms and then calms; some storms come together, like the buses (as they say), and others are widely spaced apart. But life has its ups and downs. There are many references to storms and calms in the Bible, an example is Psalm 107:29-30 "He calmed the storm and its waves quieted down. So they rejoiced that the waves became quiet, and he led them to their desired haven." If we are able to put our faith in God, he will see us through whatever storm we are experiencing. Resources: This winter's NHS **flu vaccination** programme ends on 31 January, if you haven't had it yet and are eligible contact you GP. Residents are also urged to check that they and their families are up-to-date with their **measles, mumps and rubella** (**MMR**) vaccines. Young children are offered the vaccine by their GP as part of the UK national vaccination programme. They are offered two doses of the vaccine - the first following their first birthday and the second before they start school, when they are around three years and four months

old. To check if you or your family are up-to-date with their vaccines, contact your GP.

Please note that both Churches operate a **hearing loop** system if you need it.
