# **LOURDES BY JUMBULANCE 2024:**

Wirral and Chester Across Groups are taking sick and disabled pilgrims to Lourdes on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> May – Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> June and Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> August. A Jumbulance has beds on board, spacious seating, an accessible toilet and kitchen. We stay in a four star hotel with excellent facilities to care for them and recruit a team of nurses and helpers to do so. We all do a DBS. Everyone must be COVID vaccinated. The cost is £1,095. Half price for nurses and young people under 25 in FTE. We do fund raising to help support those who cannot afford the full amount.
